

The Lung Transplant Travel Assistance Program

General information

The Lung Transplant Travel Assistance Program is a program of The Lung Association of Nova Scotia that is designed to provide modest support to individuals who have to travel out of province to receive a lung transplant.

Who Qualifies?

Residents of Nova Scotia who must travel out of the Province to receive a lung transplant.

How to Apply?

The applicant must complete the attached application form on the reverse side and forward to The Lung Association of Nova Scotia. The referring physician section must be completed and signed by the referring physician/specialized physician.

What Financial Assistance is Available under the Program?

The Lung Association of Nova Scotia provides a modest financial contribution to patients awaiting a lung transplant. The financial contribution is a one time grant per recipient.

Approval Process

All applications are reviewed on an individual basis. Once your application has been received, it will take 2-4 weeks for review of your application. If your application has been approved you should receive your bursary within 4-6 weeks upon receiving your application.
