

FAQ - Radon Mitigation Assistance Grant

1. I am using an electronic radon monitor to test my home, what needs to be included in the radon test result report to be eligible?

The radon test result report from a C-NRPP certified electronic monitor must include the following items:

- Brand and model of the detector.
- Address where the test was completed.
- Testing period of at least 3 months which is indicated with dates.
 - Ex: Month/Day/Year – Month/Day/Year
- Long-term radon results in Bq/m³ that indicates levels above 200 Bq/m³ within the testing period.

2. Where can I find certified radon mitigators for quotes?

3. How long does it take for my application to be processed?

While we can typically process applications quickly as staff capacity allows, applications may take up to 1 month to be processed.
